### EMPLOYMENT OUTLOOK

Employment of clinical laboratory workers is expected to grow 14 percent between 2006 and 2016.

**TABE test with scores in reading of 12.9 and in math of 8.0 are required to enroll. Basic typing training will be included in the class.** Phlebotomy training prepares the student to draw blood specimens from patients for the purpose of testing and analyzing blood. A phlebotomist's job includes maintenance of equipment used in obtaining blood specimens; the use of appropriate communication skills when working with patients; the selection of venipuncture sites; the care of blood specimens; the entry of the testing process into a computer; and clerical duties associated with record keeping of the blood tests.

Training is also provided in employability skills and students have the opportunity to earn a Career Readiness Certification (CRC) credential. The Career Readiness Certificate Examination fee is \$30.00. This certificate will show employers that individuals have the skills to be a successful employee.
