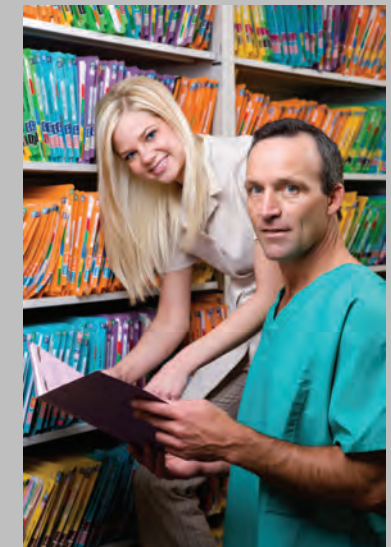

Medical Billing and Coding Courses



Medical Terminology and Anatomy for Medical Coders, Billers, and Transcriptionists

Medical terminology is the language used by medical workers to communicate at work and is suitable for all health occupation workers who communicate with physicians and other medical professionals. This three month course will unlock a world of knowledge. It is organized by body system and specialty areas of practice with an emphasis on anatomy and physiology, pathological conditions, and diagnostic techniques and procedures. The study of word-parts is integrated into and reinforced throughout the course. Students will learn new words, medical terms, and medical word parts. Additionally, they will learn to pronounce, read, and interpret medical terms in reports and charts.

Medical Billing and Coding

The second course is divided into three modules - Basic Coding, Insurance, and Advanced Coding. Students will progress through various levels of medical coding from basic through advanced. They will learn how to use the CPT, ICD-9 and HCPCS coding reference books. Additionally, they will learn how to accurately complete various types of insurance forms. The course will include sessions to prepare the students for the national certification examination.

National Certification

Upon completion of these courses, students should be prepared to test for the American Academy of Professional Coders' (AAPC) Certified Professional Coder (CPC) national certification. Information about this national certification will be provided to students during the class.
