This course is designed to provide network technicians and support staff with the foundation level skills they need to install, operate, manage, maintain, and troubleshoot a network. This course will help prepare students for the **CompTIA Network+ certification exam**. Students will learn how to install, manage and troubleshoot a variety of networks. More specifically, students will receive 90 hours of training on network protocols and standards, media and topologies, networking implementation and network support. Students will be able to identify and describe all the major networking technologies, systems, skills, and tools in use in modern PC-based computer networks, and learn information and skills that will be helpful as you prepare for the CompTIA Network+ certification examination, 2009 objectives (exam number N10-004).

Course Prerequisite: An introductory course in a Windows operating system, or equivalent skills and knowledge, is required. CompTIA A+ certification, or the equivalent skills and knowledge, is helpful but not required.
